Volunteer Manager Programme for the European Senior Championships

Tbilisi 11.-17.6.2017

Invitation

In co-operation with the Georgian Fencing Federation and under the authority of the EFC, we invite all member federations to nominate candidates for a volunteer manager programme during the European Senior Championships in Georgia 2017.

Goal

- To promote co-operation between the members of the EFC
- To provide the possibility to gain experience at a major championship
- To give the possibility to create personal international network in fencing

Target group

Members from national federations with interest in volunteering and an interest in gaining experience from tournament organisation. Participants must be able to communicate in English. We would like to find 6 participants with age not younger than 16 years old and not older than 23. In order to increase the number of women playing important roles in the fencing community we encourage you to nominate female volunteers.

Duration

Date of arrival: 12th June, date of departure: 16th June.

Program

Volunteers participate under the same conditions as national volunteers. The work is co-ordinated by the volunteer manager of the organisation. The tasks will include, depending on the individual qualifications, all the normal volunteering assignments for time- and scorekeeping, access control, handling the camera for video refereeing, etc. An additional series of seminars on relevant subjects is also planned. An EFC diploma will be issued to participants.

EFC-Comex members as well as other experts will give short lectures about the various parts of a major organization (accreditation, protocol, weapon control, technology..).

Financial conditions

EFC will allocate a lump sum of 200 € for each participant. Transportation to Tbilisi international airport is at the expense of the volunteer. Transportation from the airport Tbilisi, accommodation (in a hostel close to the venue) and meals will be provided by the Georgian organisers. The organisers will also provide food and refreshments during the competitions and the Volunteer T-shirt.
