Just within hours we received sad information from the Hungarian Fencing Federation who informed us about the passing away of

Csaba Fenyvesi (HUN)

who died yesterday at the age of 72 in Budapest after a short but severe period of illness. Mr. Fenyvesi is well known as an Olympic gold medal winner with his team in 1968 in Mexico City, and also 1972 in Munich as individual fencer and with his team. Besides these extraordinary achievements he also won three gold medals, two silver medals, and three bronze medals at world championships.

Also in his profession he worked at top level as plastic surgeon, achieved significant results in tumor surgery, both in Hungary and in the USA.

In his Budapest club BVSC he worked as manager of the fencing section for many years and also used to be member of the executive board of the Hungarian Fencing Federation.

The European Fencing Confederation sends its deepest sympathy and condolences to his family and to the Hungarian Fencing Federation.
