

Report about EFC Cadets Circuit 2019 – 2020.

Also season 2019 – 2020 was influenced by important impact of the concept of the FIE Calendar, but at general level the participation in tournaments was not touched. In any case we can state that number of participants in EFC CC increased again from 9280 in 2018-2019 reaching **10029 in 2019-2020!** The number of **countries** reached **64 (40 Europe, 13 Asia, 7 America and 4 Africa)** and special record of participation was one more time registered in **Bratislava** where the inscriptions in **men's epee** reached **347 fencers, in women epee 329 and in men's foil 252 giving in total 928 fencers in individual competitions!** Traditionally big tournament was running in **Budapest** and also in **Moedling** as the message of the federations that logistic seems be easier when they are travelling to Central Europe.

1) Main components of the Circuit

- a) **Formula of competitions:** it is giving full satisfaction.
- b) **Teams:** the team events became standard part of the Circuit. However, some organisers still do not respect the limit of maximum 5 teams per country!
- d) **Organisations** of competitions: no complaints were registered, principally all organizers respected the rules about posting pools composition day before and opening web site with on line results.
- e) **Referees.** The project dealing with evaluation of referees officiating in EFC CC continued successfully in the full electronic management and accessibility to the results for national federations and referees.
