## Information Letter no. 19-2020

Dear Member Federations,

Last Saturday we held the first ever Ordinary Congress of the European Fencing Confederation with 42 member federations present and represented. In total the Congress was attended by 69 delegates and special guests.

During the meeting delegates have taken vital decisions on regular and outstanding corporate governance issues – such as approval the financial statements and annual report for 2019, adoption of the 2021 budget and allocation of funds secured therein to directly support the federations to ensure their further existence and sustainability, approval of the auditor's report. Delegates also approved the proposed changes to the EFC Statutes and Internal Rules.

One of the results of the virtual Ordinary Congress was also the postponement of the Elective Congress with corresponding extension of the President's and Executive Committee members' terms of office until the Elective Congress set to take place on September 11, 2021 in Sochi.

On behalf of the EFC President and Executive Committee I take the privilege to express the profound appreciation to all our member federations and delegates for their proactive involvement, commitment and joint contribution to the preparation and efficient running of the virtual Congress, which will undoubtedly benefit the development of the entire European fencing community.
